Willow sculpture kits

JPR Environmental can supply kits to create a living willow sculpture in your garden or school. Included in the kit is all the willow required along with instructions on planting and maintenance. Kits are available from December to the end of March and can be delivered nationwide. We stock 5 designs but if you have a design of your own, we can estimate the amount of willow you will require and create bespoke kits. The ideal time to install a willow sculpture is in winter before the end of March in well-prepared ground and frost-free conditions.

Willow bundles

JPR Environmental provides bundles of living willow rods for you to create your own structure or to take cuttings for planting your own willow. Bundles vary from 6' in length to 10' (the number of rods per bundle varies depending on the length of the rods). Willow can be supplied in a variety of colours from reds and yellows to greens and browns, and smaller, thinner rods can be purchased for uses such as flower arranging.



Mixed willow

We manage a willow coppice at the famous Wildfowl & Wetlands Trust reserve at Slimbridge in Gloucestershire. Here we grow around 2 acres of willow which we start cutting each December for supply to the general public and for landscaping work.

Willow cuttings

Willow readily grows from stem cuttings making propagation easy. You too can grow your own willow for weaving or perhaps in the garden to enjoy the early spring catkins and winter colours that are typical of willow species. We supply cuttings from 30cm to 1m in length which can be planted straight into the ground.
